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## Argentine cuisine coming to Midtown's Ice Blocks

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The operator of a food truck known for its Argentine empanadas will soon have a presence in Midtown Sacramento's Ice Blocks project.

Che's Urban Eats will open in Ice Blocks on Nov. 28, according to the project's website. The eatery will fill a space across from Pure Barre, Bonobos and Warby Parker, it says.

In an email, Ice Blocks developer Mike Heller said Che's Urban Eats will have a "semi permanent food truck and deck patio" at the project.

On its website, Che's Urban Eats says it serves Argentine fusion cuisine, namely empanadas. The dish includes pastry dough with filling such as beef, chicken or chorizo.

Che's Urban Eats has a food truck and a catering business, according to its website. The mobile eatery has made appearances at places such as the Midtown Farmers Market. In addition, Che's Urban Eats has been selling frozen empanadas from its headquarters at 1100 Richards Blvd. in Sacramento.

A representative of Che's Urban Eats did not immediately respond to a message seeking comment. The business will join Ice Blocks eateries such as Shake Shack, Mendocino Farms and Curry Up Now.

Despite disruption from the pandemic, Midtown's Ice Blocks development on R Street has continued to add new businesses. Profile Business Photography held a grand opening for its Ice Blocks location last month. The business focuses on professional headshots, family photos and video production. It also has a San Diego location.
